Summary of work being completed and planned by WG within this year:	<b>Terms of Reference</b> updated at Annual Mtg 2023. All Members of the Endoscopy SIG have now been appointed and notified	
	with a three year second tenure from Jan 2022.	
	Established Endoscopy representative on GIC ESPGHAN for the first time in 2020 and discussions regarding this are ongoing.	
	Annual Meeting 2023:	
	Second ESPGHAN Annual Meeting Symposium of Live endoscopy cases from Rome and Sheffield occurred in Vienna 2023 and was very well attended.	
	Video cases started and will be built on next year with video abstracts planned well in advance of Annual Meeting in 2024.	
	Hands-On ELZ in Vienna was in 7 <sup>th</sup> year and another masterpiece of organisation. Company engagement was strong again. Possible EUS next year.	
	ESGE have expressed an interest in becoming more engaged with ESPGHAN after the first and very successful Joint Symposium in Vienna Annual Meeting and this is strongly supported by our new President Ulrich Baumann.	
	A Joint Polyp and Endoscopy Symposium with debates with adult colleagues was very well attended.	
	Educational Meetings:	
	Five-year plan drawn up for ESPGHAN Endoscopy Meetings outside Annual Meeting: 2024 Athens; 2025 Rome; 2026 possible Braga.	



FISPGHAN in Buenos Aires in December 2024 will be supported by ESPGHAN Endoscopy WG with plans for an ELZ equivalent and Endoscopy Symposia. MT will join LASPGHAN AGM in Rio de Janeiro in October 2023 to discuss and finalise plans for this with other representatives of the PGHAN Societies which make up FISPGHAN.
Training the Trainers Courses specific to ESPGHAN are now ongoing and Dr Narula is overseeing these in conjunction with the Education Committee of ESPGHAN and the Endoscopy WG, and discussion is ongoing as to whether, as previously agreed by the Education group, the TTT Meetings of ESPGHAN come under their auspices. This then does not impact on the GIC Education Meetings 'annual allowance'.
ESPGHAN Endoscopy Fellowships:
Engagement with major endoscopy companies to invite them to become partners with ESPGHAN along the lines of the EPP - €20,000 from Olympus and Fuji each pledged in 2022 – specifically for Trainee Fellowship funding. Unclear whether this funding has been allocated – need to discuss with ESPGHAN Treasurer.
Five were appointed in 2022/23 and have been very successful. Planned to ask some of these Fellows to present briefly their experienced in Milan in 2024.
Sponsored ESPGHAN Endoscopy Training Fellowships – also now supported by industry. Five annually. Now advertised on ESPGHAN Webpage – deadline 31/11/2023.
Network of Endoscopy Training Centres now set up with ESPGHAN recognition.
Endoscopy central training centre in Geneva not likely to happen – consideration of Athens for small thematic weekend type Courses in 2023 – polyps and PEGs are two meetings proposed. (AP)
Endoscopy Simulator purchase - Sheffield have purchased their own portable device. Can be made available for ELZ etc.
Training and Europe-wide JAG/JETS-style 'log-book' and with subsequent ESPGHAN Accreditation:
Liaison with National Societies in order to explore the possibility of ESPGHAN being the international accreditation body for paediatric endoscopy training.
Liaison with BSG in order to evaluate if they can roll out the JETS Endoscopy portfolio electronic record across Europe for paediatric endoscopy training - Grant may be needed. Explore ESPGHAN Funding Euro30,000 per annum. PN will provide a rationale and proposal paper.
Roll out of 'Train the Trainers' Courses to 3 or 4 centres in Europe – to rotate. Development of an 'ESPGHAN Standard' for certificate of completion of endoscopy training. Liaison with the ESPGHAN Education and Training WG.



Roll out of the Paediatric GRS across Europe – published in JPGN August 2019.

ESPGHAN/NASPGHAN Endoscopy Quality Indicator Guideline was finalised and 5 papers published March 2022 as JPGN Supplement.
ESGE-ESPGHAN Endoscopy Guideline being rewritten 5 years after the last one in 2023-24 – a Core planning Group will be set up and ESGE have been approached.
