Summary of work being completed by SIG within this year:	<p>Endoscopy Training Guideline completed. Endoscopy IBD Guideline published in JPGN 3.19 EoE Guideline endoscopy component completed. Trainee endoscopy report publication published. All Members of the Endoscopy SIG have now been appointed and notified with a three year tenure from Sep 2018. ESPGAN/NASPGHAN Endoscopy Quality Indicator Guideline is finalised and abstract at NASPGHAN Oct 2019. Established Endoscopy representative on GIC ESPGHAN for the first time. ESGE-ESPGHAN Endoscopy Guideline being rewritten 5 years after the last one in 2020. ESPGHAN Annual Meeting this year included a live Endoscopy Session which was extremely popular. Symposia x2 very well attended. Hands-On ELZ was in 5th year and another masterpiece of organisation and again over-subscribed.</p>

Annual ESPGHAN-accredited/approved Hands ON Endoscopy Meeting held in Athens in June 2019. Over-subscribed x5. Very successful indeed.

First Endoscopy SIG Meeting in London in Jan 2019 was very productive.

Agreed Joint ESPGHAN-NASPGHAN Guidelines on 'Small bowel endoscopy' – due to meet face to face at NASPGHAN this year. Timeline to publication end 2020.

Five year plan drawn up for ESPGHAN Endoscopy Meetings outside Annual Meeting: 2020 Rome; 2021 Sheffield (Tri-annual Endoscopy Summer School); 2022 Athens; 2023 Braga; 2024 Rome.

ESPGHAN Guidelines on FAP, Peutz-Jeghers and other polyp syndromes published early 2019 in JPGN (3 papers) – joint between Polyp WG and Endoscopy SIG.

Engagement with major endoscopy companies to invite them to become partners with ESPGHAN along the lines of the EPP.

Sponsored ESPGHAN Endoscopy Training Fellowships – also may be supported by industry. 5-10 per year.

Network of Endoscopy Training Centres now set up with ESPGHAN recognition underway.

Endoscopy central training centre not likely to happen – consideration of Rome or Sheffield as the centres for Hands On frequent beginners Hands On Courses.

Endoscopy Simulator purchase not likely to happen – Glasgow and Sheffield buying their own portable devices which could be loaned to ESPGHAN when needed.

ELZ will happen at the World Congress next year in Copenhagen.

EC failed to support live Endoscopy Session at the World Congress next year -Endoscopy SIG feel this is very short-sighted as it is an opportunity to showcase Europe as at the fore-front of the advances in paediatric endoscopy.

Only one Endoscopy Symposium at the World Congress next year but it will include a video case element thanks to Prof Husby.

Liaison with National Societies in order to explore the possibility of ESPGHAN being the international accreditation body for paediatric endoscopy training.

Liaison with BSG in order to evaluate if they can roll out the JETS Endoscopy portfolio electronic record across Europe for paediatric endoscopy training. Grant may be needed.

Roll out of 'Train the Trainers' Courses to 3 or 4 centres in Europe – to rotate.

Development of an 'ESPGHAN Standard' for certificate of completion of endoscopy training. Liaison with the ESPGHAN Education and Training WG. Syllabus important !

Training the Trainer Study module will occur in 2020 – possibly preceding the World Congress.

Roll out of the Paediatric GRS across Europe – published in JPGN August 2019.

ESPGHAN Guideline on 'Training in Paediatric Endoscopy' finalised and submitted.

Multi-centre multi-national research in paediatric endoscopy being pursued. Homan.
